Some milestones from this era:

AT BANCA MARCH

1941



Banca March comes to be chaired by **Juan March Servera**, marking the transition to the second generation.

1945



Construction ends on the Palau March, notable for its artistic and heritage value.

1947



Banca March is incorporated as a **public limited company**.

IN SPAIN

Creation of the Instituto Nacional de Industria (INI) to promote the establishment of public enterprises.



1941

The national rail company, **Red Nacional de los Ferrocarriles Españoles (RENFE)**, is established, unifying and modernising a key infrastructure for the country.



1941

Global rejection of the Franco regime produces **Spain's exclusion from the United Nations** and its international isolation.

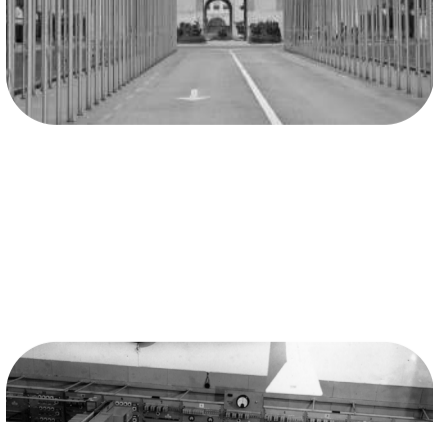
Release of **Casablanca**, one of the most iconic films in cinema history.
